

If you are applying for admission to Webster University immediately after completing your secondary education, you must present the following:

- **Bachillerato**
- **Transcripts from the last three years of senior secondary school that included subjects and marks received along with dates of attendance.**

A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0-point scale is required for undergraduate admission. This is approximately equivalent to a 7/8 on a 10-point scale or a 13/14 on a 20-point scale.

ADVANCED STANDING

If you have attended an American or International School and completed Advanced Placement Examinations or the International Baccalaureate, you may be eligible for up to 32 hours of Advanced Standing Credit. Please contact your admissions representative at the address below for further evaluation.

TRANSFER ADMISSIONS

If you are applying for admission to Webster University after having completed at least two semesters of full time study at a recognized college or university, you will be considered a transfer student. Transfer students must present the documentation as explained above in addition to the following:

- Mark sheets from all colleges and universities attended showing subjects and marks received, including division placement when applicable.
- Senior secondary school credentials (see above) if you have not completed one year of full time study.

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Webster University accepts a variety of standardized tests that measure English language proficiency. The two most common are the TOEFL and IELTS. A student with the following TOEFL or IELTS composite score has normally met the university's English language proficiency requirement:

Academically qualified students who are not yet proficient in English may be conditionally accepted into the University and placed into appropriate English as a Second Language (ESL) courses.
