

If you are applying for admission to Webster University immediately after completing your secondary education, you must present the following:

- **Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia/Malaysian Certificate of Examination (SPM/MCE), or**
- **Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia Vokasional/Vocational Malaysian Certificate of Examination (SPMV/VMCE ), or**
- **Sijil Tinggi Pelajaran Malaysia Examination (STPM), if obtained**

A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0-point scale or a C+ average is required for undergraduate admission consideration. This is equivalent to an average of 5 on the SPM and approximately a D average on the STPM.

### ADVANCED STANDING CONSIDERATION

Students who have earned the STPM may be eligible for advanced standing at Webster. Advanced Standing credit is awarded for academic subjects passed with a grade of D or better as follows:

8 credits for GCE A-Levels graded A,B,C

6 credits for GCE A-Levels graded D

### TRANSFER ADMISSIONS

If you are applying for admission to Webster University after having completed at least two semesters of full time study at a recognized college or university, you will be considered a transfer student. Transfer students must present the documentation as explained above in addition to the following:

- Mark sheets from all colleges and universities attended showing subjects and marks received, including division placement when applicable.
- Senior secondary school credentials (see above) if you have not completed one year of full time study.

### LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Webster University accepts a variety of standardized tests that measure English language proficiency. The two most common are the TOEFL and IELTS. A student with the following TOEFL or IELTS composite score has normally met the university's English language proficiency requirement:

Academically qualified students who are not yet proficient in English may be conditionally accepted into the University and placed into appropriate English as a Second Language (ESL) courses.
