



Undergraduate Admissions Profile: United Kingdom (England, Wales & Northern Ireland)

If you are applying for admission to Webster University immediately after completing your secondary education, you must submit one of the following:

- **General Certificate of Secondary Education (GCSE) with five subjects graded C or better.**
- **International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) with five subjects graded C or better.**
- **General Certificate of Education (GCE) Advanced Level or AS Level if obtained.**

A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0-point scale is required for undergraduate admission. This is approximately equivalent to a C+ on the GCSE and IGCSE and a D+ average on the GCE Advanced Levels.

ADVANCED STANDING

Webster University will award advanced standing credit for students who have successfully passed any GCE subject. For consideration for advanced standing, the results must be issued by a recognized external examination body, (for example, Cambridge or Edexcel, among others). "True Copies" of results will be accepted if the Webster Admissions Officer views the original and makes the copy. Credit is awarded as follows, to a maximum award of 32 credits:

8 credits for GCE A-Levels graded A,B,C
6 credits for GCE A-Levels graded D

4 credits for GCE AS-Levels graded A,B,C
3 credits for GCE AS-Levels graded D

TRANSFER ADMISSIONS

If you are applying for admission to Webster University after having completed at least two semesters of full time study at a recognized college or university, you will be considered a transfer student. Transfer students must present the documentation as explained above in addition to the following:

- **Transcripts from all colleges and universities attended showing subjects and marks received, including division placement when applicable. ECTS transcripts are also acceptable.**
- **Senior secondary school credentials (see above) if you have not completed one year of full time study.**

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Students educated in the UK are exempt from English language proficiency requirements.
