The Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.S.N.) program is designed for the registered nurse who wishes to advance his or her knowledge in nursing, the sciences, and the liberal arts. The program helps the registered nurse develop analytic and communication skills for professional excellence. The program also prepares the registered nurse for generalist nursing practice.

TRANSFER CREDIT

Webster University accepts 68 credits from students who have completed the Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) in Nursing. These credits will count toward the 20 credits of prerequisite coursework and the 32 credits of basic nursing education. The remaining 16 credits will count toward the 30 credits of elective courses, any remaining prerequisite and/or the 12 credits of general education. Additional college-level (non-remedial) credits earned at the community college granting the A.A.S. prior to degree completion will also be considered for transfer as elective credit.

Full-time and part-time evening study on site and/or on line is available. Courses are offered in a 8-week format. Students can complete the program requirements in two years on a part-time basis.

Webster University's B.S.N. program is accredited by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission (NLNAC).

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR B.S.N. PROGRAM

- Prior to application to the program, all R.N. applicants must have a preplanning academic advising interview with B.S.N. program personnel.
- Students are expected to have demonstrated a minimum GPA of 2.5 on prior college coursework for admission to the B.S.N. program.
- Current licensure as a Registered Nurse in the state of Missouri or for new graduate, a scheduled NCLEX exam within 3 months of beginning the program.

All applicants must successfully establish college credit in the following pre-requisite courses:
